

## Health and Safety Control of Electrical Equipment

The school maintains a policy in respect of electrical equipment brought into the School, as part of its Health and Safety management system. The following types of electrical equipment must not be brought into school:-

- 1. Toasters
- 2. Sandwich toasters
- 3. Hotplates and other cooking equipment
- 4. Open bar fires
- 5. Fan heaters
- 6. Kettles
- 7. Electric blankets
- 8. Refrigerators
- 9. Televisions

Televisions, refrigerators, kettles and toasters are provided by school, in a number of areas within the main school and boarding areas, where they are considered a tolerable risk if used correctly.

All electrical items that are brought into school must meet British Standards, as indicated on the equipment, and will need to be PAT tested by the school.
