The Exams

Three papers, tested at the end of College 2.

- Paper 1: Listening, reading and writing (2h30) – double weighted
- Paper 2: Writing - essays on two cultural topics (2h)
- Paper 3: Speaking exam – prepared discussion on a project of private study plus conversation about the topics covered in the course. (21 to 23 minutes) – double weighted

Assessment tasks will be varied and cover listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.
