Bootham School Health Centre plays a rich and vital role in the care of students. Its formal role is naturally to offer health care support and advice to the school community, but it is also able to offer pastoral support for all students and medical care to full and weekly boarders. It provides a friendly yet professional environment and can be a place of refuge when the world gets too much. A confidential counselling service is part of the support offered. The team also contributes to the delivery of the School's Personal, Social and Health Education programme (PSHE) and plays a strong role in the life of the school.

To allow the team to care for students' physical and emotional health needs, we need to ask you some important background information. When you are prompted to do so, please complete all health and medical forms as fully as possible.

Please ensure that you:

- Complete any medical forms when requested.
- Indicate whether, you give consent to treatment, information sharing and administration of medication by signing with a signature.
- Obtain a printed list of your child's vaccinations from your family Doctor's Surgery
- Register with school doctor (GP) (full and weekly boarders only)
- Complete the Dental form (full and weekly boarders only)
