## **Oral and Dental Health**

For a student's oral health it is important for them to have regular dental inspections and it is preferred that routine oral/dental treatments are undertaken in the school holidays.

Emergency dental treatment can be offered in York, for which any fees incurred are payable by parents/guardians.

Orthodontic treatment can be accessed or monitored only if a student is referred directly by his/her own dental consultant. Unfortunately the Bootham School Health Centre Team will not be able to organise referrals. It is preferred that all orthodontic appointments should be carried out in school holidays, however, in the event of a term-time concern a member of the School Health Centre Team or boarding house staff will accompany the student to an appointment. Any orthodontic fees incurred are payable by parents/guardians.
