

Guidelines for parents spectating at fixtures

As a school we are very supportive of spectators coming to cheer on our teams and we hope to make this as easy as possible. However, we also have to balance this with the need to keep the school site a safe and secure environment for students to learn, play and socialise.

This means that we cannot always allow spectators full access and we ask that you would support us in safeguarding our site and students.

Parking and facilities

During most of the School Day (08:30 – 17:00 Monday to Friday and 8:30 to 11:30 Saturday), there is no parking available on site apart from disabled parking. Please park offsite and access the school site via the Portland Street entrance. There are no accessible toilets for parents during the school day.

Getting to the fixtures

Please go straight to the area where the fixture is being held and stay within the designated areas. Unfortunately, we cannot allow access to the School buildings apart from where mentioned below. Please do not bring dogs (apart from guide dogs) onto site.

Fixtures on the Field

Spectators are welcome to stand on the edge of the pitch.

Fixtures on the Hard Courts

Spectators should use the benches or areas outside of the courts. Please be mindful that this area is also used by students.

Fixtures in the Sports Hall

Spectators may use the balcony and access is via the door at the corner of the sports hall.

Swimming Fixtures

Due to lack of space around the pool, normally spectators will not be allowed pool side.
